Today, there are more than 7,000 Rotaract clubs with some 170,000 members in over 160 countries. Rotaract clubs enable members to grow personally and professionally, address community needs, and promote international understanding through friendship and service. Rotaract clubs hold meetings, usually every two weeks, which feature speakers, discussions, and visits to other clubs.
